A volunteer organization -- "Friends of IMCK" -- has set up an endowment fund for IMCK at the Presbyterian Foundation and estimates that if each and every Presbyterian Church member in North America were to donate ONE DOLLAR, less than the cost of a soft drink, it would provide enough of an endowment (over \$2 million) for the earnings to make up the shortfall in operating needs after local fee collections and certain ongoing grants have been applied.
