 Around 30% of all women have suffered some form of physical or sexual violence.
- Women have poorer health than men; they have shorter life expectancies; they have less access to resources; they have lower literacy rates.
- And many have their <u>babies in dirty</u>, <u>unsanitary places</u> that lead to infection and death. You don't want to go there!
